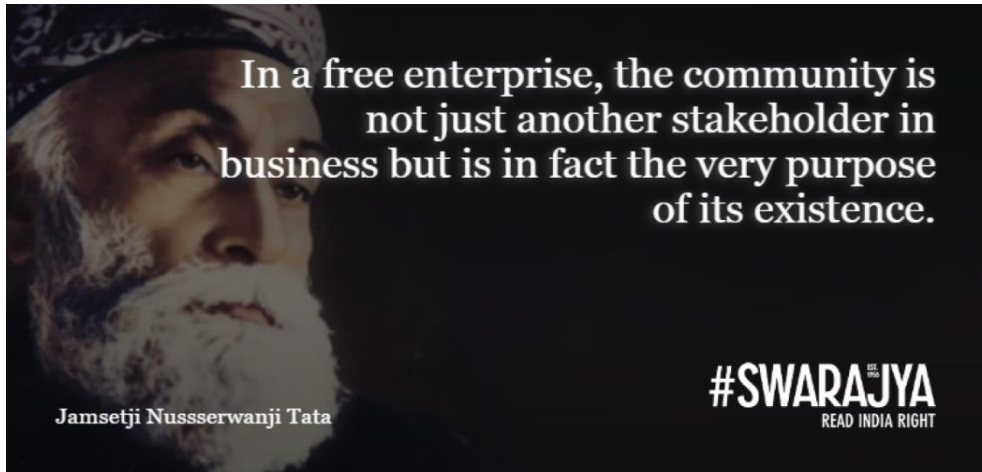

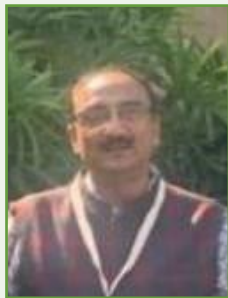

Promoting Inclusion through Pay Attention- Autism Support Network

1. Project Background:

- Partner NGO - TPCDT (Tata Power Community Development Trust)
- The 'Pay Attention: Autism Awareness Program' is a community engagement initiative undertaken by Tata Power Community Development Trust (TPCDT) and the Center for Autism and other Disabilities Rehabilitation Research and Education (CADRRE)
- The UMOYA Sports Foundation aims to provide equal sports opportunities and empowerment for people with disabilities.
- The project is aimed at increasing awareness about Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and helping people understand, accept and support individuals with Autism and their caregivers.
- The project also aims to provide access to necessary resources and support systems, as well as to create a sustainable network of champions for differently-abled individuals such as individuals with autism spectrum disorder.

2. Beneficiary Details:

- Numbers of Beneficiaries covered = 1130+
- Raising awareness on Autism among the local community: Health professionals, blue and white collar workers, shopkeepers, NGOs, teachers and others.

3. Key Highlights:

- Spreading the AUTISM free helpline number 1800 2099 488 among the laymen and encourage them to spread the same through word of mouth.
- The medium of delivery of sensitization was through Nukkad Natak (Street Theatre) interventions in key locations at Delhi/NCR.
- Umoya Sports conducted Aagaaz- an initiative to create awareness about the Disability through Sports Playing program for people with disabilities
- People were introduced to Unique Disability Identification details (UDID) in these sessions. Sessions were conducted in rural areas as well such as Villages Purkhas Rathi and Dhiran - Haryana, Ghevra village - New Delhi. Autism awareness sessions/camps were followed by interactive games so as to be engaging among audiences.
- The workshops aimed to build adapted sports mentors and trainers to give them the understanding of assessing the sports, play and developmental skills of the children and lead the on-ground sports program for children with disabilities.





Strengthening Communities and Institutions through Adhikar

1. Project Background:

- Partner NGO - TPCDT (Tata Power Community Development Trust)
- The Project was implemented in following places: Lucknow, Barabanki & Amroha. Where over 20000+ people were benefitted from this program.
- Identifying and training of Adhikar Mitras across all locations. Equipping them with the skills and knowledge to be financially independent as part of Tata Power's financial inclusivity program.

2. Beneficiary Details:

- Numbers of Beneficiaries covered = 20000+
- Raising awareness on enrollment with Government linked schemes in the local community: Health professionals, blue and white collar workers, shopkeepers, NGOs, teachers and others.

3. Key Highlights:

- 50+ Adhikar Mitras were trained during this process. People were able to create Digital health ID card, update biometrics in ration card, Aadhar Update, Pan Card (Central), Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana, E-Shram Card and updating it and many more.
- Initiative to enhance digital literacy where digital services are made available and sessions are conducted to teach and encourage people from rural areas to operate laptops and smartphones so that they become independent in availing their necessary services.
- Towards empowering people to gain access to better healthcare, education, skills and livelihood opportunities through digital literacy and digital tools.
- The organization's main focus is to make technology easily accessible to the masses, to empower women, youth, persons with disabilities and the elderly through providing functional digital literacy, media literacy, and digital upskilling across agriculture, micro and nano-business, health, education, livelihood, and entrepreneurial skills.
- 6 Soochna Adhikar Kendras, 2 in Samastipur and 4 in Muzaffarpur, have been opened targeting women and adolescent girls, youth, old age people, person with disabilities, schools/students and teachers, Anganwadi Centers (AWCs), farmers, workers and employees.

3. Key Highlights:

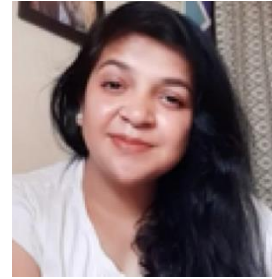
- The boot camps and training sessions were conducted across the country, and several organizations and corporates joined hands to train the participants.

- Omkar Deorukhkar from Pune, Maharashtra, represented India in the **Skill Category – Poster Designing** and his Disability is Hearing Impaired

1. Project Background:

- Partner NGO - TPCDT (Tata Power Community Development Trust)
- The program is founded on the belief that enabling women to develop their inherent potentialities will foster holistic development across society.
- The program is inclusive and tailored to accommodate diverse landscapes. Regardless of their caste, creed, or culture, women who are rape survivors, manual scavengers, transgender & disabled are included.

2. Beneficiary Details:

- Numbers of Beneficiaries covered = 62

3. Key Highlights:

- This year's program focused on promoting women entrepreneurship in Noida and Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh
- A total of 62 women were trained in stitching, tailoring, and business development in three batches of 25 each.
- USHA & Powerlinks Training cum Production Centre (TCPC) was established at Bareilly and Noida
- Apart from this Women were also oriented towards financial management, marketing and advanced stitching.
- Team also imparted trainings to rural women's & provided them with skills and opportunities to start their own micro-enterprises and become successful entrepreneurs.
- Training Completion Success of the women was celebrated with distribution of certificates.
- This initiative is an effort to create a brighter future for women in rural India by training & empowering them.





ROSHNI – Skill Building & Empowerment of PWDs SAKSHAM DIVYANG

1. Project Background:

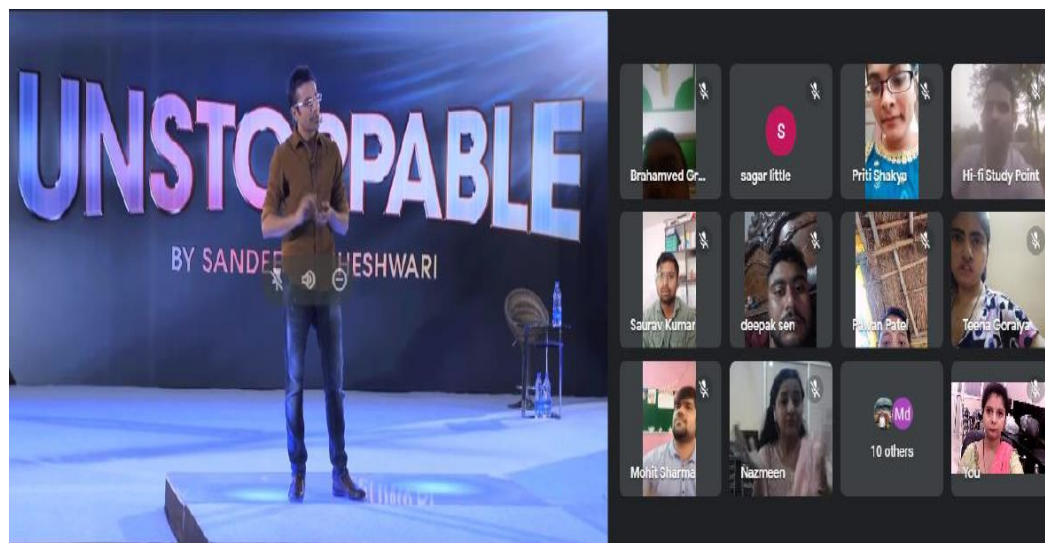
- Partner NGO - Sarthak Educational Trust
- Powerlinks has partnered with the trust to support the empowerment of PWDs in Delhi/NCR locations through a project focused on employability enhancement and sustainable employment of persons with disabilities.
- Job mapping drives are carried out to identify the skills required in the industry, and candidates are made competent and skilled to perform the job.

2. Beneficiary Details:

- Numbers of Beneficiaries covered = 300+.

3. Key Highlights:

- PWDs from different locations were enrolled in vocational skill development training that included Basic English, Life Skills, Computers, and one of the employability sectors such as IT-ITes, Organized Retail, or Tourism and Hospitality
- The training program aimed to improve the capability, capacity, productivity, and performance of individuals with disabilities.
- The most important step of the skill development program was job placement. Trainees who complete their vocational training were placed in jobs based on their skills and interests. Job placement not only provides financial independence but also raises their social status as DIVYANG.
- Team also collaborated with several allied activities such as Guest Lectures, Alumni Meet, Motivational Session, Parents Workshop, and Interaction with Team Powerlinks to provide additional learning support to PwD trainees.
- These activities aimed to enhance their understanding of various trades, reconnect with alumni, motivate candidates, assist parents in career guidance, and hold interactive sessions with team members.





ROSHNI - Integrated Digital (eVidya): Empowerment of Women through enhancing Digital knowledge and formation/capacity building of SHGs

1. Project Background:

- NGO: Society for Advancement of Village Economy (SAVE)
- Bringing social and economic empowerment to women and increase their self-confidence at New Delhi -Sangam Vihar Jhuggi Community Area
- Bridging digital knowledge gaps so that beneficiaries perform better in the community.
- Lack of SHG's and Self Defence training among women/girls.

2. Beneficiary Details:

- Number of Beneficiaries Covered = 800+

3. Key Highlights:

- Digital Knowledge enhancement of 800 women
- Formation of 5 SHGs
- Capacity building of 50 SHG members who will act as community change agents.
- Digital literacy to all the target beneficiaries
- Self- defence training to 50 women/girls of the catchment area.
- Local women have also reflected their self-made products at Tata Power Noida Office Exhibition.
- The project has organized extra-curricular activities like celebrating important days and organizing Nukkad Natak/street plays to raise awareness about the program.
- Women's were invited on various local and Tata Power Platforms to showcase their learnings, hard work and commitment towards their development and training other women neighbours for a sustainable development model





Swastha Pradesh Jan Sahayta Abhiyan

1. Project Background:

- Partner NGO -Doctors For You (DFY)
- Doctors for You (DFY), with support from Power Links Limited and Tata Power India, conducted general health camps in UP & Purnea, Bihar.
- The camps aimed to provide immediate medical relief to women, children, and community members.
- The project provided short-term relief to rural areas affected by seasonal diseases, reaching underprivileged people and raising awareness on managing common illnesses.

2. Beneficiary Details:

- Numbers of Beneficiaries covered = 11000+.
- Area covered Powerlinks line of operations - Mandola, Noida, Lucknow, Gorakhpur, Bareilly, and Muzaffarpur &Purnea.

3. Key Highlights:

- The facility was equipped with medicines and essential medical equipment. The district CMO provided guidance on healthcare services, and PHC assisted with biomedical waste disposal.
- Awareness campaigns about seasonal diseases, diabetes, heart health, fitness, yoga, and meditation were conducted, along with diabetes screening camps.
- The long-term impact aims to promote mental health management and awareness on chronic diseases like diabetes and hypertension, and provide free medicine dispensing to ensure access to necessary medication.
- In long run, the project aims to create a sustainable healthcare system and improve the overall health and well-being of the rural population.
- The project successfully spread awareness in rural areas, and the enthusiasm and participation of the villagers confirmed that they would follow the instructions given.
- The mobile units focused on screening BP, diabetes, weight, and other diseases which helped the cause of the project even more.
- The mobile clinic proved to be a great help, especially for the disabled, elderly, and homebound people.

- It also targeted diseases like diabetes and hypertension and advised people on how to manage them. These diseases cannot be cured, but lifelong control must be sought.

1. Background of the Project:

- NGO: TPCDT
- Bridging the gap between education and employment, and empowering the next generation of Indian workers to succeed in the global economy.
- Program focus on industry-driven skill development as a key aspect
- Community members enrolled in the session were trained through Vocational skill development and digital literacy initiatives

2. Beneficiary Details:

- Number of Beneficiaries Covered = 150+
- Trained SMO's = 75
- Trained DEO's = 80

3. Key Highlights:

- Program provided generic skills training, such as communication skills, problem-solving skills, and teamwork, which are essential for success in any job.
- Team also provided a comprehensive approach to skill development, ensuring that the trainees are well-rounded and prepared for a variety of job roles.
- Maximum enrolments were towards job roles in SMO (Sales and Marketing Officer) and DEO (Data Entry Operator).
- 75 individuals were enrolled for the SMO job role in batches of 20 each. Similarly, 80 individuals were enrolled for the DEO job role in batches of 20 each.
- Training Plan: Location Mapping, On boarding Team, Mobilization and Centre, Student Counselling/ Orientation, Screening and Enrolment, Training and Assessments, Soft Skills, Placement Tie-Ups, Candidates Placements, Tracking.
